## 1. INTRODUCTION:

We do not charge for any activity undertaken during school hours as part of the Curriculum.

#### 2. SCHOOLTRIPS/VISITS AND ACTIVITIES DURING SCHOOLTIME:

When organising any academy activities, trips or visits which enrich the curriculum and educational experience of the children, the Avenue Centre have decided not to ask for any contribution from parents/carers.

The following is a list of additional activities sometimes organized by the school, for example:

- team building activities;
- sporting activities sometimes involving transport expenses;
- outdoor adventure activities;

## 3. RESIDENTIAL VISITS - CHARGES:

If the Avenue Centre organises any residential visits in school time or mainly school time, which is to provide education directly related to the Curriculum, we have decided not to ask for any contribution from parents/carers.

## 4. OUT OF SCHOOL CLUBS AND ACTIVITIES:

The Avenue Centre organises on a regular basis, after school / out of hours sports and personaldevelopment sessions in conjunction with various partner organisations such as Active Support, Active Luton, Directions and various County Sports clubs and associations (Cricket, Boxing, Football, Gym and Basketball).

Currently we do not ask parents for a financial contribution but may ask for support in transporting students to and from the delivery locations if required.

#### 5. LOSS OF /DAMAGE TO SCHOOL PROPERTY:

If school property is lost or damaged as a result of a pupil's misbehaviour, parents/carers will be notified and MAY be asked to meet the costs of repair/replacement.
